Thank You To All That Have Helped! We Now Have Our Own Building.

On September 12th we finished all negotiations and signed all the necessary papers to take possession of our building. As you can see in the picture below we wasted no time in starting our fence, and replacing the old windows with dual pane vinyl windows. At the time of this report we still have 13 windows to go before cold weather hits. We have a member of



Rich Heart Baptist Church who has a window business and he has given us a bid of 4 million tugrug to replace 21 windows and 4 vacuum doors. It normally would cost that to replace 8 windows. (about \$4,000)

This building is located in the middle of dormitory row. Within a 3 block radius there are over 2500 students. Many of these have come from all over Mongolia. With this amount of space we will have many different avenues to acquaint these students with a God who loves them and a Savior who died for them.

On Sunday September 16th the church observed the Lord's Supper, and after this special service, the entire church walked the 4 blocks to the new building and met in what had been used as a



disco. While there they looked around and prayers were made asking God to dedicate this building to the furtherance of the gospel in Mongolia. Pray for these church

members as they prepare to work on this building. The church has saved 9 1/2 million tugrug in their



building fund. A member of the church who is a contractor, and is heading up the remodel of the NGO

offices, class rooms, and apartments has shown the church a design and has estimated the cost of just the church renovation to be 11 million tugrug. (\$9235) The church has committed to raise the extra 1 1/2 million tugrug. This is from people whose average wage is \$200 to \$350 a month.

Another Church in Mongolia? Soon!

Last month we reported that Brother Agi announced his call to pastor. This month Rich Heart Baptist Church sent him as a missionary to Choir with the intent to organize another Church in Mongolia in the near future. This was a momentous occasion as the church voted to send Brother Agi and pay his expenses. They expect to carry the load and expense with not a mention of churches in the states helping. One of the NGO humanitarian projects has just been completed in Choir. In 2006 the Macedonia Medical Team visited Mongolia and Choir was one of the areas visited. The hospital/clinic did not have a morgue. When someone would die they would lay in an out building until they could be buried. In the winter they would freeze and in the summer they would ...you know. There was a building on the hospital property that could be used as a morgue but they had no means of refurbishing it. Our NGO offered to take this project on. For 3 million tugrug (about \$2500) A member of Rich Heart made a silk purse out of a sows ear. This brought much favor with the ruling Mayor and those in power in Choir. Mayors have a lot of power in small towns through out the country. This will benefit us when we look for a place to locate a new church in this small town. Keep all the works in Mongolia in prayer.

The Carrells are in the states for the birth of their 7th grandchild.
