REPORT FOR June 2009

Excitement Still Continues in Mongolia

The first Sunday in June became a date to be remembered in Mongolia. On June 2nd all three congregations met for a special occasion. The Rich Heart Baptist Church voted to organize not one, but two congregations into New Testament Churches.

The two days leading up to this momentous event was filled with excitement. All members, save one, from the work in Chore had endured the 5 hours train ride to Ulaanbaatar. Then most of them spent Friday and Saturday night in the three rooms that we have prepared as dorm rooms. Saturday was spent scrubbing the sanctuary, decorating the fellowship room, and preparing food for the following days service.



Sunday morning arrived with the building packed with people. With attendance well over 130, only 2 of the Mongolians in attendance had ever witnessed a church organization service. The last time this had happened in Mongolia was in August of 2000, when 9 souls covenanted together to become the Rich Heart Baptist Church (RHBC).

Regular Sunday morning services were observed, then immediately afterwards organizational services began. First RHBC voted to organize those members who were meeting in Chingeltei. Brother Dennis Carrell called the roll of 21 members, first as individuals and then as a body they all agreed to commit themselves to fulfill the commission that Jesus gave to his church.



Then after an altar call, RHBC voted to organize those members who were meeting in Chore. Brother Agi called the

roll of 11 members and did the same thing with these members of Chore. With this accomplished, Pastor Egi brought a challenging sermon for all three Churches to reach all Mongolians with the gospel.



All three churches are now looking for villages to begin new works for the Lord. Keep the pastors of these three churches in prayer as Satan is surely not pleased with these events. Brother
