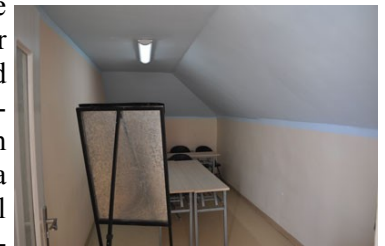


ago. On her death bed she asked Arvin to please take

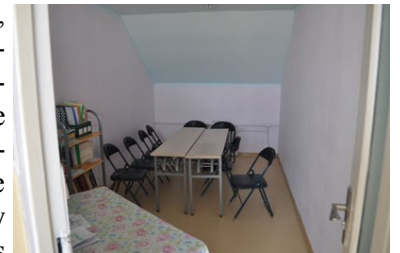
care of her daughter, she had no living relatives. Arvin has fulfilled this request by not only taking care of her physically but now eternally by showing her the way to salvation.
