As we have been reporting this past summer Sister Charlotte was diagnosed with a second bout of breast cancer. On September 20th surgery was preformed and all cancer was removed and no cancer had traveled to any of her lymph nodes. The surgery was minimal and recovery would be reduced. She begins 3 weeks of radiation treatments in mid-October with no chemotherapy. We praise God for his kindness and mercy on her behalf. She will have to return every six months for the next three years to be examined for any reoccurrence of cancer.



The Carrells are, and have been, good stewards of the Lord's money that is given to support the work in Mongolia. They still receive the same monthly support that they started with in 1999 of \$2350 a month. This is before any taxes are taken out but after their tithe. This medical emergency has been very expensive. So far, their medical deductable is \$3000, plus the expense of an extra flight to the USA, also the expense of a vehicle, food, and lodging while in the states. These faithful missionaries need not only our prayers but they also need the encouragement that your love offering could give. They both feel as if this situation is causing them to neglect the work in Mongolia, and the extra expense of future travel weighs heavily on their hearts. SIXTH YEAR OF BIBLE SCHOOL BEGINS

As the temperatures drop and winter begins in Mongolia so did our Bible School begin. This school year began the second week of September without our rock solid base. Brother Dennis and Sister Charlotte will be in the United States for most of this school year, so this left a

big hole in the teaching staff. Brother Dennis for the first two years of this school taught all the classes, and for the last three years he taught two of them. This year the Lord has led two of our men to step up and fill the gap.

Brother Agi, the pastor at Chore, has volunteered to teach our Pastors and Leaders Class. This class has 8 to 12 men attending, wanting to learn how to be the proper husbands, church leaders, and hopefully future pastors in Mongolia. Brother Agi now has two years of on the job training as pastor of the congregation at Chore.

The next class that needed a teacher was a class we call "Christology". It covers the sermons that our Savior preached while here during his personal ministry. Brother Toovshin has taken up the challenge of teaching this class.



Brother Toovshin led out in the remodel and the building of the church buildings in Chore and Chingeltei. It was just over two years ago that Brother Toovshin was accepted by the Rich Heart Church as a teacher. Many believed he would fail as a teacher because he has a stuttering problem that at times can be severe. Mongolians as a whole do not have much patience nor tolerance for disabilities. But Toovshin put everyone's doubts to rest after just a couple of lessons. He puts his all in studying and delivering his lessons to the Church and he is doing the same for the Bible School. He is a great example of God using anyone willing to give their all to his service.

Please keep this school year in prayer. Out of 38 students 10 are not of the Baptist faith. Pray that they will be able hear and understand the truth about the Church as the Bride of Christ and the importance of serving God in the proper place.
