SISTER SUNDAY SCHOOLS

BIBLE INSTITUTE COMPLETES 6TH YEAR

Many churches around the world have Bible classes to help train future pastors and leaders, and to further the knowledge of their church members. Mongolia is no different, but I think I can say that there are few in the world that can match the dedication of those in Mongolia. When it is time for classes none of our students will go out to their car and drive to class. Many of the students have to walk

to class because they do not have money for taxi or bus. Most of them will walk a mile or more to get to classes. The others will have to walk to bus stops only to be dropped off almost a half mile away from the church building.

You may say that's not so bad, but here is the rest of the story. Bible School goes through the winter. There were many days and nights that the temperatures were -20 to -28 degree below zero. But they still came. If anyone missed a total of 3 classes they were given an incomplete and received no certificate. You would see them walk in the door, many of them hurting from the cold, but they still came.

The students this year did not say they were hungry for the Word of the Lord, they showed it by their attendance and on their faces as the lessons were being taught. Three of our five teachers this year were Mongolian. What a thrill and blessing to see God raising up men to lead and teach. Many are already talking about next year. EXCITING NEWS OUT OF UGINOOR

Uginoor has come a long way. This next school year, if the Lord is willing, we will be connected with Uginoor and they will be able to participate in our Bible Institute classes over the internet. The only place in Uginoor that has internet is the local school. Permission has been given for Brother Erdenbayer and the church to come to the schools classroom and take part in the class. We hope the novelty of this will also bring others to come and listen to God's Word.

That is not all, this last month Brother Erdenbayer baptized 4 and they were added to the church. This has been a long teaching process for them to understand baptism. The only thing that those in Uginoor have known is Buddhism and baptism is a strange thing.
